

Registration

Please fill out the registration form in this brochure and return it to the Bellevue East Counseling Department as soon as possible. Some classes will fill up; making your selections early will help ensure the course of your choice in Summer Term.

Classes with insufficient registration as of June 1, may not be offered. Class lists will be posted the first day of Summer Term.

Attendance

Regular attendance is necessary if credit is to be earned. Students missing more than 600 minutes of an academic class will be dropped from the class with no credit earned. Absences due to vacations will be counted toward the total minutes.

Discipline

Students who are sent to the Dean of Students' office for disciplinary reasons will not be able to return to that class for the remainder of the period. The time out of class will be counted towards the 600 minute total. Students are encouraged to monitor their breaks and return to class on time as tardies to class will result in a loss of minutes. All school rules as stated in the Parent-Student Handbook will be enforced.

Through the Summer Term program, the Bellevue Public Schools, under the leadership of Dr. John Deegan, Superintendent, provides a continuing education program for all of our students.

- Providing an expanded learning time for students;

PASS/FAIL CREDIT

- **Algebra I:** This course is open to students who have passed one semester of Algebra I and are in need of another credit, or those students wanting a review of Algebra before taking Geometry or Algebra II.
- **Geometry:** This class is open to students who have passed one semester of Geometry and are in need of another credit, or those students wanting a review of Geometry before taking Algebra II.
- **Algebra I-1:** This class is open to students who have passed one semester of Algebra I-1 and are in need of another credit.
- **Algebra I-2:** This class is open to students who have passed one semester of Algebra I-2 and are in need of another credit.
- **World History:** This course is open to students who need to make up a credit in World History.
- **American Government:** This course is open to students who need to make up a credit in American Government.
- **American History:** This class is open to students who need to make up a credit in American History.
- **English:** This course is open to students who need to make up a credit in English.
- **Biology:** This course is open to students who need to make up credit in Biology.
- **Physical Science:** This course is open to students who need to make up credit in Physical Science.

- **Physical Education:** This course is open to students who take a full schedule of academic classes and are unable to complete Physical Education class during the regular school year. **Requirement:** Approval from counseling staff.
- **Health:** This course is open to students who take a full schedule of academic classes and are unable to complete Health class during the regular school year. **Requirement:** Approval from counseling staff.
- **One credit awarded upon successful completion of a course. Summer School courses are graded as Pass or Fail and course grades will not affect a student's GPA.**

Non-Credit Course Offerings

- **Spanish I:** This course is open to students who took Level I and passed, but did not meet the standards of a 70% or better to advance to Level II. **Requirement:** Approval from current Level I teacher. *(A non-credit course only)*
- **Weight Training and Conditioning:** Open to all students grade 7-12 who will be attending East. Students must attend both the running and lifting session in order to enroll. Classes meet Monday-Thursday.
