2010 GENERAL MARTIN G. COLLADAY SCHOLARSHIP

Background

The Air Force Association is a nationwide organization that works to promote a strong national defense through air and space power for the 21st Century while advancing the welfare of the men and women who serve in our Armed Forces worldwide. Within the organization, the Aerospace Education Foundation sponsors scholarships, grants and other awards that benefit America's outstanding students as they strive to further their education. AFA members are drawn from all elements of American society, and are united in their devotion to keeping America a strong, free and democratic nation in a violent world.

Criteria

The Ak-Sar-Ben Chapter of the Air Force Association will award several \$1,000 scholarships to college-bound graduating seniors in the Omaha metroplex. Scholarships will be awarded based on merit, to students pursuing technical academic studies at an accredited college or university, with a long-term goal of an Air Force career. {Applicants who have already been awarded full tuition scholarships are not eligible}. All applicants must be certified by a High School counselor as students in good standing, with a grade point average of 2.8 or higher at time of application. Selection of recipients will be made by a panel of members from the chapter. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the college or university at which the recipient enrolls as soon as the chapter is provided with proof of admission as a full-time student.

Procedures

1. Complete the attached application form in full.
2. Have a High School counselor sign the form certifying you are a student in good standing {GPA 2.8 or higher} and will graduate at the end of the spring semester.
3. Attach a copy of your High School transcript.
4. Attach a copy of a Letter of Recommendation from at least one person who is not a relative, who is aware of your performance in school, and overall character.
