### Show-n-Tell

We will use the "Sharing Bag" for our show-n-tell. Students will take turns bringing the bag home. When it's your child's turn, he/she may bring one or two items to share. Do not send items that can be broken. Please try to make the item(s) educational. It is also helpful if you have a short discussion about the item(s) at home so your child is prepared.
