We brightened up our classroom this week as we learned about Colors and Light. Monday, we read the book, Colors and created our own books about colors. We worked hard on them all week and will be sharing them with you at conferences in a couple of weeks. Tuesday, we read Little Blue, Little Yellow and practiced mixing colors with colored water.

Wednesday, we made Rainbow Stew. (The recipe is included if you want to try it at home.) With the "Stew" and with food coloring in water, we learned about the primary and secondary colors. We made rainbows on the ceiling with a prism. We talked about how raindrops are nature's prism and the light is from the sun. We also explored with light and shadows. We found that light passes through some things like glass or cellophane, but not cardboard.

*Rainbow Stew *

The "K" had so much fun making this recipe that they wanted me to share it with you.

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1/3 Cup sugar

1 Cup cornstarch

4 Cups water

Mix over medium heat, stirring constantly. The mixture takes about 5 minutes to thicken. Divide the mixture into three bowls. Mix one with red food coloring, one with blue food coloring, and one with yellow food coloring. Put a small "glob" of each color into a zipping sandwich bag and you can mix the colors together!
